H 1465. DISPOSAL IN LANDFILLS/ADDL. BANS. TO PROHIBIT THE DISPOSAL OF CLEAN WOOD WASTE, ELECTRONIC DEVICES, MOTOR VEHICLE OIL FILTERS, PLASTIC BOTTLES, AND WOODEN PALLETS IN LANDFILLS. Amends GS 130A-309.10(f) as title indicates. Enacts new GS 130A-309.10(k) to authorize any county or city to request a waiver of new prohibitions. Makes conforming and technical changes. Effective October 1, 2009.

H 1465. DISPOSAL IN LANDFILLS/ADDL. BANS. Intro. 4/21/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes proposed definition of plastic bottle in GS 130-290(a). Amends proposed amendment to GS 130A-309.1(f) (list of solid wastes prohibited from being disposed of in landfills) to delete electronic devices and clean wood waste and replace plastic bottles with plastic containers that are required to be labeled, have a neck smaller than the container's body, and have screw or snap top. Specifies that prohibition of plastic containers does not apply to rigid containers used for motor oil.

H 1465. DISPOSAL IN LANDFILLS/ADDL. BANS. Intro. 4/21/05. Senate amendments make the following changes to 2nd edition. Amendment #1 prohibits disposal of oyster shells in landfills. Amendment #2 allows disposal of wooden pallets in landfills that are permitted to accept only construction and demolition debris.
