H 1481. COMPOUNDING PHARMACY PERMITS/FEEES. REQUIRING PHARMACIES ENGAGING IN THE COMPOUNDING OF DRUG PRODUCTS TO OBTAIN A COMPOUNDING PHARMACY PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF PHARMACY TO IMPOSE A FEE FOR THE PERMIT UNDER THE LAWS REGULATING THE PRACTICE OF PHARMACY. Enacts new GS 90-85.21C as title indicates. Sets fee for compounding permit at \$500. Exempts from requirements the reconstituting of antibiotic powders; making of non-sterile topical preparations from commercially available products; occasional assembly, when ordered by prescription, of active ingredients commonly available from wholesale drug distributors; and locations accredited by organizations approved by the pharmacy board.
