**H 1507. AMEND INTERPRETER/TRANSLITERATOR LICENSE ACT. TO AMEND CERTAIN LAWS UNDER THE NORTH CAROLINA INTERPRETER AND TRANSLITERATOR LICENSURE ACT, TO EXPAND THE GROUP OF PERSONS WHO MAY OBTAIN A PROVISIONAL LICENSE UNDER THE ACT, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE NORTH CAROLINA INTERPRETER AND TRANSLITERATOR LICENSING BOARD TO ASSESS CIVIL PENALTIES.** Amends GS Chapter 90D as title indicates. Exempts from licensing requirements nationally certified interpreters or transliterators that provide services in NC for no more than 20 days a year. Deletes provision in GS 90D-8 authorizing the issuance of a provisional license to persons holding certain course certificates. Enacts new GS 90D-8(a1) to authorize Board to issue a provisional license to persons who have satisfied the listed criteria. Authorizes Board to conduct administrative hearings in accordance with GS Chapter 150B, Article 3A, and to assess a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 for violations of Chapter 90D. Lists factors Board must consider before imposing penalty and requires that Board establish a schedule of civil penalties and assess the costs of disciplinary actions against a person found to be in violation of Chapter.
