As title indicates, includes in definitions of "electioneering communication" in GS 163-278.80 and 163-278.90 (currently applicable only to clearly identified candidate for statewide office or for General Assembly), a clearly identified candidate for any other state or local office for which territory for electorate has total population of more than 10,000 as of most recent federal decennial census. Effective January 1, 2006, and applicable to primaries and elections held on or after that date.
