H 1536. STUDY DECONSOLIDATION OF LARGE LEAS. TO ESTABLISH A STUDY COMMISSION ON DECONSOLIDATING LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS THAT HAVE MORE THAN SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND STUDENTS. As title indicates. Comm'n to consist of six members each appointed by House Speaker and Senate President Pro Tem., one of the six must be school board member or county commissioner who is from county with local school unit that has more than 75,000 students and is in favor of deconsolidation. Comm'n to make final report of findings and recommendations to 2006 legislative session. Effective July 1, 2005.
