H 180. HIGH-RISK HEALTH INSURANCE STUDY. TO ESTABLISH THE STUDY COMMITTEE ON HIGH-RISK HEALTH INSURANCE POOLS. As title indicates, establishes 15-member Study Committee, six members to be appointed by the Speaker, six by the Pres. Pro Tem., and two by the Governor. Provides that the Commit of Insurance or designee shall serve ex officio. Requires that Committee study the following issues concerning high risk insurance pools: available funding sources and financing mechanisms; terms, pricing, and coverage eligibility; and the impact pools would have on the operations of other health insurance companies. Requires that Committee make final report to the 2007 General Assembly and terminate thereafter. Intro. by Setzer.
