Amends GS 136-28.1(a) to require the Department of Transportation (DOT) to use in connection with federal aid projects the contract provisions for differing site conditions, suspensions of work ordered by the engineer, or significant changes in the character of work developed by the DOT and approved by the Board of Transportation. Current law requires that the DOT Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures and administrative rules be used in connection with contracts involving federal aid projects.
