RELATING TO THE POWERS OF THE STATE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER, TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PROJECT MANAGEMENT, AND TO DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EXEMPTIONS; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES FOR TWO PROCUREMENT ATTORNEY POSITIONS. GS 147-33.83 gives the Office of Information Technology Services powers and duties with respect to all executive departments and state agencies, except the Department of Justice if it elects not to participate. This bill removes the exception for the Department of Justice and makes a conforming change to GS 147-33.91(b). It also makes technical changes to GS 147-33.72E (information technology project management

standards). Appropriates \$298,826 for 2006-07 from the General Fund to the Office of Information Technology Services to fund two attorney positions to assist with information technology procurement.
