H 199. FAILURE TO MOVE LEFT - FINE INCREASED. TO INCREASE THE FINE FOR A VIOLATION OF THE INFRACTION OF FAILING TO MOVE LEFT WHEN PASSING AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE PARKED OR STANDING IN A ROADWAY. GS 20-157(f) currently requires that a driver move over at least one lane when passing an emergency vehicle that is emitting a warning signal and is parked within 12 feet of a roadway; or if changing lanes is not possible, that the driver operate vehicle at a reduced speed while passing emergency vehicle. Act imposes a fine of up to \$250 for violations of that subsection. Effective Dec. 1, 2005. Intro. by Setzer.
