**H 231. POWERS AND DUTIES OF STATE CONTROLLER. TO REVISE THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE STATE CONTROLLER.** Amends GS 143B-426.39 to authorize Controller to review state agency compliance with uniform accounting standards and legal and constitutional requirements. Requires resulting work papers and related material to be made available to state and federal government representatives in connection with official matters. Specifies that work papers are not public records but that reports resulting from compliance reviews are public records.

**H 231. ST. CONTROLLER/COMPLIANCE REVIEW/PUB. RECORDS (NEW).** Intro. 2/15/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Transfers provisions concerning records disclosure and public records protections to new GS 143B-426.39B. Makes discretionary the State Controller's disclosure of work papers to government officials and deletes the provision requiring disclosure to these officials of other evidence and supportive material relating to the work papers. Clarifies that supportive materials, like work papers, are not public records. Makes technical changes.
