H 355. RESTRICT USE OF BLUE AND RED VEHICLE LIGHTS. *TO RESTRICT THE USE OF CERTAIN RED AND BLUE LIGHTS ON VEHICLES, INCLUDING RED AND BLUE WINDSHIELD WASHER LIGHTS.* Amends definitions of “red light” and “blue light” in GS 20-130.1 to include any forward facing red light or blue light installed on a vehicle after initial manufacture, including a red or blue windshield washer light and a light placed on a vehicle dashboard that is similar in appearance to a blue light used by a law enforcement officer. Effective December 1, 2005 and applicable to offenses committed on or after that date.
