H 669. OVERSIZE/OVERWEIGHT VEHICLE CHANGES. TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING OVERSIZE AND OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES. Amends GS 20-96(a) by adding a property-hauling vehicle with an oversize or overweight load in violation of GS 20-119 to the types of property-hauling vehicles that a law enforcement officer may seize and detain. Amends GS 20-117 to provide that the load on a vehicle shall not exceed 14 feet beyond the rear of the bed or body of a vehicle. Amends GS 20-119 by authorizing the imposition of civil penalties up to \$10,000 where an oversize or overweight vehicle operates without the issuance of a required permit, operates off permitted route of travel, operates without the proper number of certified escorts, fails to comply with travel restrictions of the permit, or operates with an improper license. Makes technical changes. Effective July 1, 2005.

**H 669. OVERSIZE/OVERWEIGHT VEHICLE CHANGES.** Intro. 3/16/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Excepts vehicles transporting forestry products from GS 20-117 provision that no load may extend more than 14 feet beyond the rear of a vehicle. Amends GS 20-118(e)(5) to specify that violation of a permitted weight under GS 20-119 is not a criminal offense punishable pursuant to GS 20-176. Amends GS 20-119(d) to increase from \$10,000 to \$25,000 the proposed minimum fee for violation of permit requirement. Makes technical changes.

### May 5, 2005

H 669. OVERSIZE/OVERWEIGHT VEHICLE CHANGES. Intro. 3/16/05. House amendment makes the following change to 2nd edition. Amends GS 20-119(d) to clarify that the proper number of certified escorts for oversize or overweight vehicles will be determined by the actual loaded weight of the vehicle combination.

## August 10, 2005

**H 669. OVERSIZE/OVERWEIGHT VEHICLE CHANGES.** Intro. 3/16/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 3rd edition. Amends GS 20-117 to also exempt utility poles from the prohibition against a vehicle load extending more than fourteen feet beyond the rear of a vehicle. Amends GS 20-118(c)(4) to exempt from the light-traffic road weight limits vehicles transporting supplies, material, or equipment necessary for the construction of housing or land when the vehicle's destination is located solely on the light-traffic road. Makes technical change.

## August 13, 2005

H 669. OVERSIZE/OVERWEIGHT VEHICLE CHANGES. Intro. 3/16/05. Senate committee substitute and committee amendment adopted 8/12/05 make the following changes to 4th edition. Deletes proposed amendment to GS 20-118(c)(4), which would have created an exception for vehicles transporting property necessary for construction or land development. Changes effective date from July 1, 2005, to October 1, 2005.
