H 683. ADD INFO ON PROTECTING NEWBORN TO CURRICULUM. TO INCLUDE INFORMATION IN THE SCHOOL HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAM ABOUT THE MANNER IN WHICH A PARENT MAY LAWFULLY ABANDON A NEWBORN BABY WITH A RESPONSIBLE PERSON AND TO DIRECT LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO ENSURE THAT HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS RECEIVE THAT INFORMATION. Amends GS 115C-81 and enacts new GS 115C-47(45) as title indicates.

H 683. INSTRUCTION/INFO. TO PROTECT NEWBORN (NEW). Intro. 3/17/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to *AN ACT TO REQUIRE LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO ENSURE THAT STUDENTS IN GRADES EIGHT THROUGH TWELVE RECEIVE ANNUAL INSTRUCTION OR INFORMATION ABOUT THE MANNER IN WHICH A PARENT MAY LAWFULLY ABANDON A NEWBORN BABY WITH A RESPONSIBLE PERSON*. As title indicates, modifies proposed GS 115C-47(45) to give local school districts the option of offering either information or instruction on lawful abandonment of a newborn baby. Deletes proposed GS 115C-81(e1)n., which would have required that school districts include information on lawful abandonment in the school health education program.
