H 689. MONROE MEALS TAX. TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF MONROE TO LEVY A PREPARED FOOD TAX. Authorizes the City of Monroe to levy a prepared food and beverage tax of up to 1% if approved by the voters of the city in the 2006 municipal election. Identifies several exemptions from food tax. Provides for the collection and administration of the tax and requires the county to refund taxes paid by certain nonprofit and governmental entities. Requires that tax proceeds be used for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a civic center.
