Amends GS 58-86-35 and 58-86-40, allowing for termination of membership in Firemen's Pension Fund by member. Makes conforming changes. Effective July 1, 2005.

H 710. RETIREMENT SYSTEMS TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS. Intro. 3/17/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 135-106(a) to provide that participants or beneficiaries who do not have five years membership service within the 96 calendar months prior to becoming disabled (was, prior to the conclusion of the short term disability period) or upon cessation of continuous salary payments, whichever is later, are not eligible for long-term disability benefits. New provision is effective December 1, 2004, and sunsets August 1, 2005.
