Modifies proposed GS 143-59.4 to require that the Secretary of Administration retain the statements required by section and report annually to the Joint Legislative Comm'n on Governmental Operations on the number of contracts that are expected to be performed outside the United States.

House amendment adopted 5/10/05 amends the 2nd edition, as amended, to clarify that the requirement that the Secretary of Administration retain the statements required by GS 143-59.4 applies regardless of which State entity awards the contract.
