H 830. E-NC VOTING MEMBERS/JOB CREATION FUNDS. *(1) APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE E-NC AUTHORITY FOR CREATION OF JOBS AND BUSINESSES BY CONTINUATION OF E-NC ACTIVITIES TO SUPPORT INFRASTRUCTURE DEPLOYMENT AND TECHNOLOGY-BASED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE RURAL AND DISTRESSED URBAN AREAS OF THE STATE AND FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF TWO ADDITIONAL E-NC BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY TELECENTERS AND (2) PROVIDING THAT ALL MEMBERS OF THE E-NC GOVERNING COMMISSION MAY VOTE.* Effective July 1, 2005, appropriates \$500,000 for 2005-06 and \$500,000 for 2006-07 from General Fund to the e-NC Authority for operations and \$1 million for 2005-06 from the General Fund to the e-NC Authority to establish two e-NC Business and Technology Telecenters in distressed regions of the State. Increases from nine to fifteen the number of voting members of the e-NC Comm'n by extending voting rights to the six ex-officio members of Comm'n. Requires that e-NC Authority work with certain listed State and local governmental and nonprofit entities in implementing act.
