Enacts new GS 115C-316.1 to require school counselors to implement a comprehensive counseling program in their schools and spend 80% of their time providing direct services to students. Direct services are defined as delivery of the guidance curriculum, individual student planning, and responsive services such as family consultation and crisis counseling. Direct services do not include coordinating standardized tests. New requirements become effective with the 2006-07 school year, with local school boards to implement an advance transition plan and the State Board of Education to provide guidelines and report to the Joint Legislative Comm'n on Governmental Operations.
