Completely rewrites bill to amend SL 3004-108, as rewritten by SL 2005-305 and SL 2006-25, to add Surry County, Wilkes County, and the Town of Surf City to areas in which law enforcement officers and municipal and county employees may operate unregistered all-terrain vehicles on highways with speed limits of 35 miles per hour or less. Conforms title.

**H 845. LOCAL ATV USE/WHITEVILLE UNSAFE BUILDING (NEW).** Filed 3/21/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Amends SL 2004-108, as amended, to also add Gaston County and the Town of Ocean Isle Beach to areas in which law enforcement officers and municipal and county employees may operate unregistered all-terrain vehicles on highways with speed limits of 35 miles per hour or less. Also amends Section 4 of SL 2002-118, as amended, to add Whiteville to the list of municipalities that may declare residential buildings in community development target areas unsafe and demolish those buildings using the same process authorized for the demolition of unsafe nonresidential buildings. Conforms title.
