H 964. SUSPEND INVOLUNTARY ANNEXATIONS. TO SUSPEND INVOLUNTARY ANNEXATIONS AND TO ESTABLISH A BLUE RIBBON COMMISSION TO STUDY INVOLUNTARY ANNEXATIONS. As title indicates, creates 10-member Comm'n and prohibits municipalities from initiating or continuing involuntary annexations until Comm'n has submitted final report to the 2007 General Assembly. Provides that five members of Comm'n will be appointed by the Speaker and five members by the President Pro Tem. Requires that Comm'n study current statutory procedures for involuntary annexations by municipalities, including whether those procedures adequately protect the rights of property owners.
