H 967. HEALTH CARE POWER OF ATTY/DISPOS. OF REMAINS. Intro. 3/29/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes proposed amendment to GS 32A-19. Amends GS 32A-16 to add definition of "disposition of remains" as the decision to bury or cremate human remains. Amends GS 32A-25 (statutory form health care power of attorney) to add a paragraph in which the person executing the document may place limitations on the agent's decisions regarding autopsy, anatomical gifts, and disposition of remains. Amends GS 130A-398 to add a health care agent acting under a health care power of attorney as a person who may authorize an autopsy. Amends GS 130A-404(b) to include in the list of persons who may authorize anatomical gifts a health care agent acting under a health care power of attorney. Changes effective date from date the act becomes law to October 1, 2005, applicable to powers of attorney created before and after that date.
