S 1039. INCREASE RAPE PENALTIES/HELPLESS VICTIMS (NEW). Intro. 3/24/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes amendment to GS 14-27.3 and 14-27.5 that would have deleted force as an element of the offenses of second-degree rape and sexual offense. Deletes proposed new GS 15A-1340.16E, which would have enhanced the punishment for conviction of first- or second-degree rape or sexual offense if committed by using date rape drugs. Enacts new GS 14-27.2(3) and 14-27.4(3) to provide that if a person who commits rape or a sexual offense against a person who is mentally disabled or physically helpless knows or reasonably should know of victim's condition, person is guilty of first-degree rape or first-degree sexual offense, respectively. Provides that prosecutions for offenses committed before effective date of act are not abated or affected by act.
