S 109. HANDGUN PERMIT RENEWAL/DEPLOYED MILITARY. TO GRANT TO DEPLOYED MILITARY PERSONNEL AN EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO RENEW A CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMIT. As title indicates, extends time period within which military personnel may renew permit issued under Ch. 14, Art. 54A, to 90 days after end of deployment to Iraq. Also provides that expired permit remains valid during individual's deployment and until expiration of 90-day renewal period provided by section. Applicable to members of United States armed forces and reserves and NC Army National Guard and NC Air National Guard who were called to active duty in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom on or after Jan. 1, 2003.

S 109. HANDGUN PERMIT RENEWAL/DEPLOYED MILITARY. Intro. 2/10/2005. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Adds GS 14-415.16A to provide that military permittee (defined as deployed military member who holds a permit to carry a concealed weapon) or the permittee's agent may apply for an extension of the permit by providing the sheriff with a copy of the permittee's proof of deployment, and sheriff must extend permit for a period to end 90 days after the military member's deployment is scheduled to end. Also provides that if a permit expires during a military permittee's deployment without being extended, permit remains valid during the deployment and for 90 days after the end of the deployment as if it had not expired. Permittee must apply to renew the permit within 90 days after the end of deployment and bring proof of deployment to the sheriff. Specifies that permittee may carry concealed weapon during that 90-day period before renewal if displays proof of deployment to law enforcement officer.
