S 1127. DOT MINORITY/WOMEN BUS. PROGRAM/SBE PROJECTS (NEW). Intro. 3/24/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Enacts new Article 30 of GS Chapter 120 to establish the

12-member Joint Legislative Comm'n on the Dep't of Transportation Disadvantaged Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Businesses Program, five members to be appointed by the Speaker, five members by the President Pro Tem., and the cochairs of the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee or their designees to serve ex officio. Sets forth duties of the Comm'n and requires that the Dep't of Transportation report quarterly to the Comm'n on efforts made to achieve the goals of the program established by GS 136-28.4. Provides that new Article 30 will expire June 30, 2015. Enacts new GS 136-28.10(d) to require that the Dep't of Transportation set a spending target of \$100 million per biennium for Small Business Enterprise projects.
