S 1156. DAIRY STABILIZATION AND GROWTH PRGM (NEW). Intro. 3/24/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Replaces blank bill with AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH CAROLINA DAIRY STABILIZATION AND GROWTH FUND TO PROVIDE CRITICAL SUPPORT FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA DAIRY INDUSTRY. Enacts new Article 68A of GS Chapter 106 to establish the NC Dairy Stabilization and Growth Program and Fund. Program requires that the Board of Agriculture set a milk support baseline price and provides that in the event the monthly announced Class I price mover is lower than the baseline price established by Board, dairy farmers are eligible for a quarterly Fund distribution equal to the difference times the amount of milk each farmer sold. In order for a farmer to receive assistance under the Program, Grade A milk producers must demonstrate compliance with federal regulations applicable to those producers and other milk producers must demonstrate compliance with Article 26 of GS Chapter 106. Requires that the Comm'r of Agriculture file an annual report with various General Assembly Committees no later than March 31 regarding the NC dairy industry and the new program. Appropriates \$25,000 for 2005-06 to the Dep't of Agriculture and Consumer Services to comply with reporting requirements. Effective July 1, 2005.
