The composition of the Waterfront Access Study Committee is enlarged from 17 to 18 by addition of the Chair of the Wildlife Resources Commission or the Chair's designee.

S 1352. WATERFRONT ACCESS STUDY COMMITTEE. Filed 5/11/06. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Increases the committee's membership from 18 to 20 by deleting a representative of the real estate development community and adding (1) a representative of the residential building industry in a coastal region, (2) a licensed realtor, and (3) a director of a public parks and recreation agency located in a coastal region. Deletes the \$50,000 appropriation and directs the Legislative Services Commission to allocate funds for the study.

July 18, 2006

S 1352. WATERFRONT ACCESS STUDY COMMITTEE. Filed 5/11/06. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 3rd edition. Increases the membership of the committee from 20 to 21, adding one member involved in economic development in a coastal region, to be appointed by the President Pro Tem. of the Senate, and changing the member who is a director of a public parks and recreation agency from a position appointed by the President Pro Tem. to an ex officio position to be held by the President of the NC Recreation and Parks Association. Changes the interim report date from November 1, 2006, to January 15, 2007, and changes the final report date from January 15, 2007, to April 15, 2007. Makes a conforming change to Section 10 and makes the bill effective when it becomes law (was, July 1, 2006).
