**S 1375. NOTARY PUBLIC CORRECTIONS.** Filed 5/15/06. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes amendments to GS 10B-106(d) and replaces them with amendments to GS 10B-68 and 47-41.2 to make the provisions under GS 10B-68 and 47-41.2 apply retroactively to the cure of technical defects in notarial certificates and commissioning or recommissioning of a notary issued on or after December 1, 2005, and become effective July 1, 2006. Amends SL 2006-59 to make GS 10B-99 effective July 3, 2006. Makes amendment to GS 10B-20(I) effective October 1, 2006.
