Changes title to AN ACT TO ALLOW STATE-OWNED PROPERTY TO BE MOVED FROM ONE COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT TO ANOTHER AND TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM ANNUAL PER DIEM OF MEMBERS OF WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITIES. Amends GS 162A-5(c) to increase the maximum annual per diem that a county water and sewer authority member may receive from \$2,000 to \$4,000. Per diem increase applies on the first day of the authority's fiscal year that begins on or after the date the act becomes law.
