S 1608. NO IN-STATE TUITION IF UNLAWFULLY IN US. Filed 5/17/06. TO CLARIFY THAT PERSONS NOT LAWFULLY IN THE UNITED STATES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR IN-STATE TUITION AT ANY CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OR AT ANY COMMUNITY COLLEGE. Amends GS 116-143.1 by adding language to subsections (a)(1) and (b) and by adding new subsection (d1) making clear that to qualify as a resident for the purpose of in-state tuition at University of North Carolina constituent institutions and at NC community colleges, a person must be lawfully in the US. Amends GS 115D-39 by adding new subsection (d) providing that a person who is not lawfully present in the US will not be eligible for the in-state community college tuition rate. Effective when the act becomes law.
