S 171. ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE AND ATHLETICS ISSUES (NEW). Intro. 2/21/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Requires that the NC High School Athletic Association (NCHSAA) create a small school conference if at least five high schools within a NCHSAA geographic region decide to form that conference. Provides that a small school conference may be created for the 2005-06 school year if the participating schools notify NCHSAA of their decision no later than September 15, 2006. Applicable only to Dare, Hyde, Martin, Tyrrell, and Washington counties. Provision is identical to Section 102.7 of fourth edition of S 602, adopted 8/30/05. Makes technical change.
