**S 193. NC BRIDGE AND TOLL ROAD AUTHORITY.** *TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE NORTH CAROLINA BRIDGE AUTHORITY TO THE NORTH CAROLINA TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY, TO AUTHORIZE THE RENAMED AUTHORITY TO CHARGE A TOLL ON A NORTH-SOUTH PRIMARILY RURAL INTERSTATE HIGHWAY, AND TO DIRECT THE USE OF TOLL PROCEEDS TO EXPANSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THAT INTERSTATE AND FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES.* Amends GS Ch. 136, Art. 6F, as title indicates.

Authorizes the NC Toll Road and Bridge Authority to levy tolls to expand or maintain any north-south interstate that does not pass through a NC city with a population of greater than 250,000. Requires that tolls not exceed \$10 and be collected only at the Virginia and South Carolina borders.
