S 193. NC BRIDGE AND TOLL ROAD AUTHORITY. TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE NORTH CAROLINA BRIDGE AUTHORITY TO THE NORTH CAROLINA TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY, TO AUTHORIZE THE RENAMED AUTHORITY TO CHARGE A TOLL ON A NORTH-SOUTH PRIMARILY RURAL INTERSTATE HIGHWAY, AND TO DIRECT THE USE OF TOLL PROCEEDS TO EXPANSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THAT INTERSTATE AND FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES. Amends GS Ch. 136, Art. 6F, as title indicates. Authorizes the NC Toll Road and Bridge Authority to levy tolls to expand or maintain any north-south interstate that does not pass through a NC city with a population of greater than 250,000. Requires that tolls not exceed \$10 and be collected only at the Virginia and South Carolina borders.
