Department of Environment and Natural Resources must evaluate whether technology prevents loss of coastal property, determine desirability of establishing a general permit for this technology, and report its findings and recommendations to the Environmental Review Commission by December 1, 2008. Appropriates \$25,000 for 2006-07 to Town of North Topsail Beach to implement pilot program.
