S 210. EXTEND SUNSET/ANIMAL DISEASE PREVENTION. TO EXTEND THE SUNSET PROVISION OF THE ACT THAT STRENGTHENED THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE VETERINARIAN TO PREVENT AND CONTROL AN OUTBREAK OF FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE AND ANY OTHER CONTAGIOUS ANIMAL DISEASE. Extends from October 1, 2005, to October 1, 2009, the sunset provision in SL 2001-12, as amended, which enacted GS 106-399.4, 106-399.5, 106-401(b), and 106-402.1 allowing the State Veterinarian to develop and implement certain emergency measures to prevent and control the spread of serious contagious animal diseases and imposed a maximum administrative penalty of \$10,000 per violation for concealment of an animal subject to quarantine or for failure to report certain animal diseases. Effective October 1, 2005.
