S 217. DRIVERS LICENSE REVOCATION FOR ABC VIOLATION (NEW). Intro. 2/24/05. Senate committee substitute deletes all provisions of 1st edition and replaces it with AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REVOCATION OF THE DRIVERS LICENSE OF ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF GIVING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO, OR AIDING AND ABETTING THE PURCHASE OR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY, AN UNDERAGE PERSON AND TO ALLOW FOR A LIMITED DRIVING PRIVILEGE.
