S 220. ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE/NOMINATION/ELECTION UNC BOG. Intro. 2/28/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Adds following provisions to previously blank bill:

Nomination procedure. Sets schedule for nomination process for the eight seats to UNC Board of Governors to be elected by the Senate. Nominations must be submitted by a senator during the week of March 14-18, 2005. Directs Senate Committee on Higher Education to screen candidates and submit a slate of possible candidates that does not exceed twice the number of seats to be elected.

Elections. Specifies election procedure, including date (no later than April 6, 2005) and method to conduct runoffs and to break ties. Each senator voting must vote for as many candidates as there are vacancies to be filled by that election, and ballots must be signed and made available for public inspection.
