S 317. DISTRICT JUDGE 8-YEAR TERMS. TO AMEND THE NORTH CAROLINA CONSTITUTION TO PROVIDE EIGHT-YEAR TERMS FOR DISTRICT COURT JUDGES.

Requires a referendum during the statewide general election in November 2006 on proposed amendments to Section 10 of Art. IV of NC Constitution to increase term from four to eight years, as title indicates. Upon approval of referendum by voters, effective beginning with district court judges elected in the 2008 general election. Makes conforming changes.
