S 33. PILOT VOTE BY MAIL. TO ALLOW A TRIAL PROJECT FOR VOTING BY MAIL IN MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS AND REFERENDA CONDUCTED IN MAY OF 2005. As title indicates, allows State Board of Elections to conduct voting by mail upon the request of city council and county board or boards of elections for municipality with a population of 90,000 or more. Requires that State Board of Elections adopt policies and procedures for such elections or referenda, including those concerning absentee voting and the eligibility of voters reporting address changes after the close of registration. Board is further required to report to the General Assembly on adopted policies and procedures and on the act's implementation.
