S 335. CORNELIUS CHARTER AMENDMENT (NEW). Intro. 3/3/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Replaces blank bill with *AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF CORNELIUS TO ALLOW THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO REMOVE MEMBERS FOR CAUSE.* Amends Sec. 3.3 of SL 1971-288, as amended by Town Ordinance No. 2002-00266, to provide for removal from office of mayor or commissioner upon majority vote of board of commissioners upon finding that mayor or commissioner has attended fewer than 60 percent of all regular board meetings in a 12-month period. Amends bill to provide for service by mayor and commissioners until their successors are elected and qualified, until they resign, until they become ineligible to hold office, or until they are removed from office for failure to attend requisite number of meetings. Provides for appointment of mayor or commissioner pursuant to GS 160A-63 in the event of a vacancy in the office.

S 335. CORNELIUS CHARTER AMENDMENT. Intro. 3/3/05. Senate amendment makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Expressly allows mayor or commissioner to miss board meetings without being considered absent in three circumstances: (1) personal illness or illness or death of immediate family member; (2) military service; and (3) official duties. Places burden on mayor or commissioner to document authorized non-attendance.
