FACILITIES (=H 454).** *TO CLARIFY THAT GUARANTEED ENERGY SAVINGS CONTRACTS INCLUDE CONSERVATION MEASURES FOR WATER AND OTHER UTILITIES, TO RAISE THE CAP FOR GUARANTEED ENERGY SAVINGS CONTRACTS, TO EXPAND THE STATE'S ENERGY POLICY AND LIFE-CYCLE COST ANALYSIS TO INCLUDE THE CONSERVATION OF WATER AND OTHER UTILITIES, AND TO MAKE CONFORMING CHANGES.* Identical to H 454, introduced 3/3/05.

**S 402. WATER/UTILITIES SAVINGS IN GOVT. FACILITIES.** Filed 3/5/05. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends definitions in rewritten GS 143-64.17 by expressly including meters in equipment to which changes can be made to achieve conservation goals. Includes captured lost revenue as energy savings. Changes proposed aggregate amount of State financing contracts in GS 142-63 from \$75 million to \$100 million (current law, \$50 million). Adds new section revising GS 143-64.17B(a) to include a utility system in authorized subjects for approved energy savings contracts. Adds new section revising GS 142-64(b)(2) governing the financing of an energy conservation measure for a governmental unit by extending the maximum term of the financing from 12 to 20 years from the date of project acceptance. Adds provision stating that the act applies to contracts entered into or after the effective date, which is when the act becomes law.
