Renumbers proposed GS 14-280A to GS 14-280.2 and further modifies section to provide that any person who willfully points a laser device at an aircraft while the device is emitting a laser beam (was, who intentionally and without legal authorization discharges a laser at an aircraft) while the aircraft is taking off, landing, in flight, or otherwise in motion is guilty of a Class H felony.
