S 494. REGULATE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES. Intro. 3/15/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Replaces blank bill with *AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE DEPLOYMENT OF COMPETITIVE BROADBAND SERVICE BY PUBLIC UTILITIES.* Enacts new GS 62-2(b1) to provide that the NC Utilities Comm'n may not regulate broadband service. Enacts new GS 62-3(1) to define broadband service as any service that includes a high-speed access capability to transmit at a rate of at least 200 kilobits per second and is used to provide Internet access or computer processing, information storage or content, or protocol conversion, but does not include intrastate service that was tariffed by the Comm'n and in effect as of the effective date of subdivision.
