S 516. TRAVEL ALLOWANCE FOR APPELLATE JUDGES. TO AUTHORIZE A TRAVEL ALLOWANCE FOR APPELLATE JUDGES WHO RESIDE FIFTY MILES OR MORE FROM RALEIGH. Amends GS 7A-10(b) and 7A–18(a) to provide that appellate judges who reside fifty miles or more from Raleigh will be paid a weekly travel allowance for each week the judge travels from home to Raleigh for business of the court. Allowance to be calculated based on actual round-trip mileage at the business standard mileage rate set by the Internal Revenue Service in Rev. Proc. 93-51, December 27, 1993. Effective July 1, 2005.
