S 547. AMEND CERTAIN LAND SURVEYOR LICENSURE REQS. AMENDING CERTAIN LICENSURE AND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE NORTH CAROLINA ENGINEERING AND LAND SURVEYING ACT. As title indicate, amends GS 89C-13(b) to require that applicant for a professional land surveyor license who has not passed the Fundamentals of Surveying exam (first exam) by January 1, 2013, must meet the following additional experience requirements, which vary by individual's degree: (1) bachelor of science degree in surveying – two years of experience working with a practicing professional land surveyor; (2) associate degree in surveying technology – eight years of experience, four of which must have been with a professional land surveyor; (3) high school graduate – sixteen years of experience, nine of which must have been under a practicing professional land surveyor. Provides that land surveyor applicants with an associate degree who have not passed first exam by January 1, 2013, may take first exam after four years of experience, two of which must be under a professional land surveyor; and that high school graduates who have not passed first exam by January 1, 2013, may take first exam after ten years of experience, six of which must be with a professional surveyor. Further amends section to require that applicant for a land surveyor intern license with an associate degree must have four years of experience, two years of which must be with a professional land surveyor; and that an applicant with a high school degree must have ten (was, five) years of experience, six (was, four) with a professional land surveyor. Also requires that graduate of a surveying curriculum or a student who has attained senior status in accredited program for four years or more be admitted to the Fundamentals of Surveying exam.
