S 700. FLAG/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE IN SCHOOLS (NEW). Filed 3/17/05. House committee substitute replaces 2nd edition with a new act *DIRECTING LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION*, *CHARTER SCHOOLS, THE NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOL OF THE ARTS, AND THE NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS TO REQUIRE THE DISPLAY OF THE UNITED STATES AND NORTH CAROLINA FLAGS AND TO REQUIRE THAT RECITATION OF THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE IS SCHEDULED ON A DAILY BASIS.* Amends GS 115C-47(29a) to require local boards of education to adopt policies to require that the United States and North Carolina flags be displayed in each classroom, when the flags are available, and to require that recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance be scheduled on a daily basis. Current GS 115C-47(29a) encourages (rather than requires) local boards of education to adopt policies that provide for the display of flags and that provide an opportunity for students to recite the Pledge of Allegiance on a regular (rather than daily) basis. Enacts new GS 115C-238.29F(k), 116-69.1, and 116-235(i), to impose the same requirements on charter schools, the NC School of the Arts, and the NC School of Science and Mathematics, and to require instruction on the meaning and origins of the flag and the Pledge of Allegiance.
