S 72. EXPAND COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH MEMBERSHIP. TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN COUNTIES TO EXPAND COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH MEMBERSHIP TO INCLUDE A RESTAURANT OWNER. Authorizes the board of commissioners in a county with a population in excess of 400,000 (currently, Guilford, Mecklenburg, and Wake) to adopt a resolution adding a twelfth member to the board of health who is a restaurant owner and resident of the county. Specifies that if a restaurant owner is not available for appointment, an additional representative of the general public may be appointed to serve until a restaurant owner becomes available.

S 72. COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH MEMBERSHIP. Intro. 2/8/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to "*AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN COUNTIES TO CHANGE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH MEMBERSHIP TO INCLUDE A RESTAURANT OWNER.*" Amends GS 130A-35, applicable to counties with population in excess of 400,000, to authorize county board of comm'rs to change membership of cited board to reduce number of public members by one and add one member who is a restaurant owner and resident of county (original bill, expand membership of cited board to include one member who is a restaurant owner and resident of county).
