S 756. REVISE BUILDING COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP. TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE STATE BUILDING COMMISSION. Amends GS 143-135.25 as title indicates. Increases Comm'n from 9 to 12 members. Requires new members to be a commercial contractor, a minority business contractor, and an attorney whose primary practice is construction law.

S 756. REVISE BUILDING COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP. Intro. 3/22/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. (1) Amends GS 143-135.25(c) to increase membership of State Building Commission to 13 (was, 9; original bill, 12) and to provide that the additional member will be either a licensed architect with primary practice in the design of buildings or a registered engineer with primary practice in the design of engineering systems of buildings, appointed by the Governor to a term expiring June 30, 2009. (2) Modifies subdivision (c)(10) to require that the building contractor or subcontractor (or employee) member be a licensed general contractor (or employee).

S 756. REVISE BUILDING COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP. Intro. 3/22/05. Senate amendment makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Increases number of members on the State Building Comm'n from 13 to 15, adding a public member appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tem. of the Senate and a public member appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House. Modifies initial terms for some Comm'n members.
