**S 883. MECKLENBURG COUNTY/DISPOSE OF SEIZED FIREARM (NEW).** Intro. 3/23/05. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes amendments to GS 15-12 and makes the following amendments to GS 15-11.1 applicable only to Mecklenburg County: (1) authorizes notice by publication in a newspaper prior to disposing of a seized firearm when the owner of the firearm is unknown, and (2) permits either the sheriff or chief law enforcement officer of any agency with jurisdiction to destroy a firearm in accordance with a court order. Changes effective date to when act becomes law.
