S 929. PRISON ESCAPE/JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY. TO MAKE IT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE TO BREAK OUT OF A JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY OR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CENTER. Amends GS 14-256(b) to create new criminal offense to break a juvenile facility or to escape from the custody of an official of the facility or center. Violation is a Class A1 misdemeanor. Also changes punishment for certain prison breaks and escapes from custody from a Class 1 to a Class A1 misdemeanor . Applies to offenses committed on or after December 1, 2005.

Provides that offenses added by bill apply only to individuals 18 and over. Adds an offense of escaping from the lawful custody of a law enforcement officer or employee of the Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention.

Modifies proposed GS 14-256 to delete provision making offenses apply only to individuals 18 and over. Clarifies that offense of escaping from the lawful custody of a law enforcement officer or employee of the Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention applies only while individual is being transported to or from those facilities described in subsection.
