S 950. ENLARGE STATE PARK ADDITION IN CUMBERLAND. TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ENLARGE THE CARVERS CREEK SANDHILLS AREA BEING CONSIDERED AS A POTENTIAL STATE PARK TO INCLUDE ADJOINING PROPERTY ON THE CAPE FEAR RIVER AND TO CONSTRUCT AND ESTABLISH A DAM AND RESERVOIR ON THIS PROPERTY TO SERVE AS A REGIONAL WATER SUPPLY. As title indicates. New water supply is to serve Fort Bragg and Pope Air Force Base and the surrounding area. Requires that Div'n of Parks and Recreation of the Dep't of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) have engineer determine blueprint that specifies boundaries of enlarged area and that DENR purchase additional land consistent with the blueprint. Further requires that DENR request that NC Congressional delegation apply to Congress for appropriations to fund land purchase and dam construction and that DENR also request funding from other listed sources. Effective July 1, 2005.
